Dear Valued Mayfair Road Food Pantry Customers,

We're all getting a lot of information and daily news updates on the coronavirus and the spread of COVID-19. We are closely monitoring the situation from multiple resources like the <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)</u> and the Department of Health and Human Services. We are creating measures to keep everyone safe during this time, as we value the safety of all of our customers and staff above all else.

To ensure continued safety, there will be changes made to the Mayfair Road Food Pantry **effective Wednesday 03.18.20**, and these changes will remain in effect until further notice.

What will this look like?

Hours of operation will continue to be on Wednesdays 12pm-3pm. Staff will sign you in at the food pantry doors toward the back of the parking lot (near the playground) and there will be pre-packaged boxes/bags of non-perishable items for you to pick up; however, there will no longer be a gathering place.

Feeding America has limited our selection of food to contain only non-perishable items. Because the food boxes are pre-packaged, we are unable to accommodate specific requests and are limited to the stock at hand. We will be distributing meat or fresh produce as we receive it, but it is not guaranteed..

What if you're sick?

We ask that you not come during walk-in hours to help prevent the spread of infection. Instead, please email us or call 813-786-1048 and staff will set aside a box for you to pick up at the church between 3:15-3:30pm on Wednesday. Staff can meet you outside the church at your car to ensure you get the box, and you can return to your home safely.
