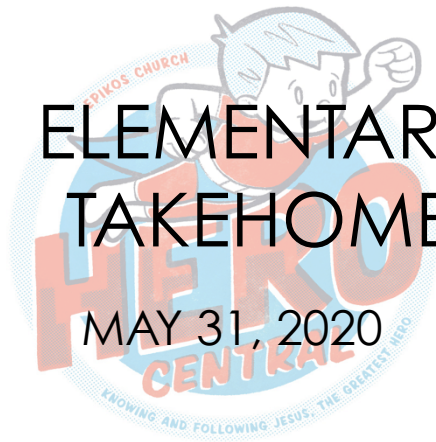

REVIEW PAST LESSONS WITH YOUR KIDS

Lesson 6, Jesus Is King: When Jesus entered Jerusalem riding on a donkey, the Israelites recognized Him as King. How have you been able to honor Jesus as King in your life recently?

Lesson 7, The Big God Story: Jesus came to erase our sins and restore our relationship with God. How did you feel when water was washed clean in the cup?

Lesson 8, God Is Love: God loves the world—what an amazing fact! How have you experienced God's love for you?

Lesson 9, Jesus Is Compassionate: Compassion means "to suffer with." Compassion isn't just a feeling; it leads to action. How has God used other people to have compassion on you? How has God given you compassion for other people?

Lesson 10, God Is Near: Jesus is near to us just like He was near to Peter when he started to sink. Have you had any situations in your life lately where you knew Jesus was near?

Lesson 11, Jesus Restores: How does it make you feel to know that Jesus can restore our hearts to wholeness in Him?

Lesson 12, Jesus Is Life: It's amazing to know that Jesus is life! Did any of you make a decision to follow Jesus?
