ASK THESE QUESTIONS WITH YOUR KIDS

Q: **Why did God bring His people out of Egypt?** Exodus 5:1

A: So they could throw a festival in the wilderness to celebrate God.

Q: **What did the Israelites do when they were thirsty and hungry?** Exodus 15:24; 16:3

A: Complained, wished they were dead or back in slavery in Egypt.

Q: **How did God give His people the water and food they needed?** Exodus 15:25; 16:13; 17:5-6

A: Turned bitter water into drinkable water by having Moses throw a piece of wood in it. Delivered quail to the camp. Covered the camp in dew in the morning. Moses struck a rock with his staff as directed and water came gushing out.

Q: **How have you seen God take care of you and your family?**

Q: **How did God give His people the rest they needed?** Exodus 16:23

A: He set aside one day of complete and Holy rest. They were to cook what they needed the day before to have rest on the Sabbath day.

- Of the Ten Commandments, the first four commandments focus on relationship with God.
- The fifth commandment focuses on our relationship with parents.
- The last five commandments focus on our relationship with one another.
- As the laws stood, they only brought knowledge of sin. God knew this, so He sent the Holy Spirit to enable us to obey the law that He writes on our hearts (Hebrews 8:10).
