

Epikos | North Side Worship Leader - Job Expectations

Position Expectations:

These are some details of the expectations. This document isn't all-inclusive. Expectations might shift due to ministry needs but expectations will always be communicated and discussed.

General

- In partnership with the Worship Pastor and Team, set the vision for the worship experience at epikos | North Side
- A love for multi-ethnic and biblically diverse worship services
- Invite and empower others to be a part of the Worship and Tech team
- Help worship and tech team members to grow in their love for God through mentoring and caring for them
- Assist the Worship Pastor in scheduling and implementing services
- Coordinate and help facilitate worship team auditions
- Help to develop worship team through quarterly meetings, rehearsals, time spent one on one with those on the worship team
- Transportation to be able to get between locations
- Lead worship ~45 Sundays per year
- Opportunities for songwriting and recording are available

Weekly

- Fill out Planning Center Online Details
- Oversee band and tech on Sunday morning at North Side. (Some Sundays you might lead at different locations.)
- Pick songs with Worship Pastor and other worship associates
- Email songs to band weekly
- Set up for rehearsal, direct the band in rehearsal
- Run weekly rehearsals
- Transport gear to and from North Side every week (from West Allis location to Barack Obama H.S. and back to West Allis after service)
- Youtube video uploads (will train)
- Podcast edit/upload (will train)
- ProPresenter Slide creation (will train)
- Do sermon video pre-record (future)
- Participate in all service planning meetings. Take notes at meetings.

Other

- Learn Planning Center Online
- Help refine Audition materials for North Side
- Record harmony vocal parts for North Side songs. Work with Worship Pastor.
- Create new song charts. Work with other musicians or staff if needed.
- Sales of old music/tech gear
- Help with any tech installs or stage design builds (new installation or fixes) at any location.
- Develop a plan for scheduling band and musicians for future

Typical Weekly Schedule

Mon - 9am–5pm

Tue - 9am–5pm

Wed - 9am–5pm

Thur - 12pm– 10pm (lunch and dinner breaks in between)

Fri - off

Sat - off (exception of other special one-off events, or ministry meetings etc)

Sun - services 7am– ~1pm, afternoon auditions sometimes between 2-4, tech at east occasionally for PM services/or FUSE youth group. Transport of gear after services back to West Allis. Youth use for their Sunday PM meeting.

The schedule might shift if needed and flexibility in ministry is important. It is typical to work 44-48 hours per week.
