OUR PRAYERFUL GOAL OF ROOTED + BUILT UP IS TO PURCHASE A PERMANENT BUILDING FOR OUR NORTH SIDE CAMPUS—SHERMAN PARK—AND TO PLANT A NEW, FOURTH CAMPUS— MAYFAIR ROAD.

Our goal is to take on no new long-term debt.

We plan to fund the entire cost of the project with three-year commitments of generosity from the Epikos family. Short-term borrowing may be used to better align the projected income and expense schedules.

The impact of our \$2.7M investment.

Establish Sherman Park + Mayfair Road Campuses

- Purchase of buildings to secure permanent homes for both campuses to facilitate our mission of making more and better disciples throughout the city of Milwaukee and the metropolitan area
- Complete atmosphere overhaul to the worship centers which includes audio, video, and lights to create a modern worship experience
- Creation of safe and fun children's ministry environments so kids can learn about and begin to follow Jesus
- Lobby expansions to welcome new people through our doors and foster long-lasting, gospel-centered relationships
- Heating and cooling improvements to keep everyone comfortable all year-round
- Restroom expansions and upgrades

East Side + West Allis Campus Improvements

We will complete special capital projects that will enhance the worship experiences at our East Side and West Allis campuses.



Visuals of proposed improvements represent general depiction of finished spaces for both campuses. Completed project may vary depending on availability of materials, color selections, and funds.











Step 2. Choose how you want to give.

If recurring, choose frequency (weekly, monthly, etc.) and start date. Choose fund (*Rooted and Built Up*). Click next and follow instructions given in the donation portal.
